## Encouraging Learning

This part of the mission at Circle Christian School is realized by offering a wide range of options to our students. Since its foundation in 1985, Circle has served the educational needs of Central Florida students and families.

Circle provides families two educational options. In the *university hybrid approach* a student attends courses one or more days a week receiving the accountability benefits of face-to-face instruction in a private-school environment, while also working at home with the active involvement of parents partnering in the education of their child. Circle also offers families a traditional *homeschool approach*. In both choices, Circle provides administrative oversight and academic structure coupled with an extensive support and activity network.

The school utilizes three campus locations (Winter Park, Oviedo, and Winter Springs) to provide convenient access for the students we serve. Circle provides an accredited academic program as well as outstanding athletics and arts opportunities for its students.

All enrolled students at Circle have the option of participating in campus courses and programs. All CCS offerings are designed to partner with, guide, and support our families in their educational choices, and provide a community with which to share the educational journey. The following pages provide information needed to register for Circle courses and programs. These pages include instructions and a schedule grid of all the offerings at each of the three campuses. There is also a worksheet (page 12) to assist you in making your course selections. We invite you to carefully consider the information presented here and use those items that will most enhance your student's educational experience.

## Current Circle Students

Before a current student can register for any course or program, the family must be up-to-date (in good standing) on ALL REPORTS and FEES for the current school year.

## New Students

Before a new student may register in any course or program, a complete student application for enrollment must be submitted. Circle will assign Family and Student Numbers after receipt of student applications. Family and Student Numbers are necessary to complete the registration process.

## Terms and Conditions

1. All courses and programs are based on a 30 week schedule, unless otherwise noted.
2. If, for any reason, the student does not attend a course session, payment is still due.
3. By enrolling in course/program offerings, the parent is agreeing to the conditions of payment for the entire school year.
4. The cost of each course/program is based on the sum of two fees, a Registration Fee and a Course/Program Fee. The Registration Fee is a non-refundable fee paid at the time of registration. The Course/Program Fee must be paid, either in full by August 1, 2018, or in ten monthly installments from August 1-May 1. FINANCIAL COMMITMENTS FOR EACH COURSE/PROGRAM ARE FOR THE ENTIRE ACADEMIC SCHOOL YEAR. SOME COURSE AND PROGRAM OFFERINGS ALSO HAVE ADDITIONAL FEES THAT ARE NOT INCLUDED IN THE REGISTRATION AND COURSE/PROGRAM FEES.
5. Course sizes are limited. Therefore, registration is on a first-come first-serve basis. When courses are filled, students will be placed on a waiting list as requested by the parent. If a course does not have sufficient registration, parents will be contacted and registration fees will be refunded. Course offerings, instructors, and schedules are subject to change without notice.
6. Some courses/programs have prerequisites or require administrative approval to participate. In such cases, course registrations will NOT be in full effect until all approvals are met.
7. After a registration has been received and processed, an e-mail will be sent to the family outlining the registration that was received. It will be the responsibility of each family to confirm the accuracy of the registration. If a student has been placed on a waiting list for any course, the "wait list" status will be noted on the confirmation.
8. For all new student applicants, this registration process is provisional and probationary. Course registrations will NOT be in full effect until all application procedures have been completed and the student has been accepted into enrollment. In the event an application is not accepted, all course and program registration fees will be refunded. Registration for courses does not obligate Circle to accept a student into enrollment.
9. Parents must fully disclose any and all mental, emotional, or physical handicaps or disabilities or other concerns that may affect any student's academic performance, social interaction, or behavior in any course or program.
10. ALL REGISTRATIONS ARE PROVISIONAL AND PROBATIONARY. NO COURSE REGISTRATIONS WILL BE IN FULL EFFECT UNTIL ALL CIRCLE POLICIES, PROCEDURES, AND APPROVALS HAVE BEEN SATISFIED AND COMPLETED. In the event that Circle declines a registration for any reason, all fees paid in conjunction with the registration will be refunded. The Circle Christian School administration is the sole judge in all disputes.



# How to Register for Campus Programs and Courses



## Registration Resources

## Items Needed to Register

You must have a *Circle Family Number* and a *Student Number* for each student that you wish to register. These numbers are issued by Circle to new families after receipt of the student and family applications.

## Course Numbers

Courses are offered at three campus locations. Many courses have the same name but are differentiated by grade levels. Each course has a unique three-digit Course Number that designates the different locations and grade levels. Be sure to select courses from the appropriate schedule in order to ensure that you are registering for the correct location and grade level.

## Full Program vs Individual Courses

Some offerings are day long programs. These programs are only available as a package; you must register for the entire program, individual courses are not an option. Other offerings may be selected as individual courses. In each of these environments you choose the specific courses. Consult the Course Guides for details.

## Schedule Grids

The schedule grids show the courses, programs, electives and activities that are offered at each location. Remember each course has a unique three-digit Course Number related to the day, location, and grade level of the course.

## Worksheet

A worksheet has been provided (page 7) to assist you in scheduling your course and program selections. We suggest that you prepare one worksheet for each student since you must register each student individually. Use the worksheet to arrange your day by placing the Course Number in the appropriate “period” box. Remember that “day long” programs are not period dependent. When you are confident that your worksheet is complete, you are ready to register.



## Online Registration

All online registrations are date and time stamped and enter the system as received. An Internet link to the registration page will be posted on the Circle website just prior to the opening of registration. In addition to the information on the worksheet, you will need a credit card or Paypal account to pay the registration fees.

## Alternate Methods of Registration

If you are unable to access a computer to register for courses, there are two alternate methods of registration available, by fax and in person. Staff will begin accepting registrations at the Circle office according to the schedule listed above. Faxed and in person registrations DO NOT receive priority status and will be entered into the system as staff is available. Faxed and in person registrations are not date and time stamped.

## Registration by FAX or in person at the school office

You may fax (407-740-8580) your registration or bring it to the Circle office.

Three items must be included:

1. A completed *Course and Program Registration Worksheet* (page 12) listing all course/program selections for each student.
2. A signed *Course and Program Registration Terms and Conditions Form* (page 13) listing the names of all students that you are registering for courses.
3. An appropriate means of payment. If registering by fax, a signed *CCS Credit Card Authorization Form* (page 14) to pay for the registration fees is required. If registering at the office, a check, cash, or credit card may be used.

## Terms and Conditions

1. All courses and programs are based on a 30 week schedule, unless otherwise noted.
2. If, for any reason, the student does not attend a course session, payment is still due.
3. By enrolling a student in the course/program, the parent is agreeing to the conditions of payment for the entire school year.
4. The cost of each course/program is based on the sum of two fees, a Registration Fee and a Course/Program Fee. The Registration Fee is a non-refundable fee paid at the time of registration. The Course/Program Fee must be paid, either in full by August 1 each year or in ten monthly installments from August 1–May 1. **FINANCIAL COMMITMENTS FOR EACH COURSE/PROGRAM ARE FOR THE ENTIRE ACADEMIC SCHOOL YEAR. SOME COURSE AND PROGRAM OFFERINGS ALSO HAVE ADDITIONAL FEES THAT ARE NOT INCLUDED IN THE REGISTRATION AND COURSE/PROGRAM FEES.**
5. Course sizes are limited. Therefore, registration is on a first-come first-serve basis. When courses are filled, students will be placed on a waiting list as requested by the parent. If a course does not have sufficient registration, parents will be contacted and registration fees will be refunded. Course offerings, instructors, and schedules are subject to change without notice.
6. Some courses/programs have prerequisites or require administrative approval to participate. In such cases, course registrations will NOT be in full effect until all approvals are met.
7. After a registration has been received and processed, an e-mail will be sent to the family outlining the registration that was received. It will be the responsibility of each family to confirm the accuracy of the registration. If a student has been placed on a waiting list for any course, the “wait list” status will be noted on the confirmation.
8. For all new student applicants, this registration process is provisional and probationary. Course registrations will NOT be in full effect until all application procedures have been completed and the student has been accepted into enrollment. In the event an application is not accepted, all course and program registration fees will be refunded. Registration for course does not obligate Circle to accept a student into enrollment.
