Count = School Day Count | Students must obtain 180 days of school. This calendar reflects one way to obtain the required number of days. Extension weeks are designed for home instruction under parent direction.

In class, Frameworks students receive teacher instruction in Literature, Writing, History, and Science. At home, students work through a Weekly Assignment Sheet (WAS), which is a 3-day checklist of assignments that must be completed. Teachers grade assignments in the subjects covered in the program. Parents must add Math, Grammar, and Bible curriculum to round out their students core academic subjects. There is no WAS for Extension Weeks. Note: Overview is subject to change
